Now in stock at Northwest Stoves, the Marquis Skyline III VRB46N linear zero clearance fireplace. Much like its predecessor, the Skyline II ZRB46, the Skyline III produces magical flames with a wide-view appeal for today’s consumer.

What’s new with the Skyline III is the optional enclosure grill (GK-V46EG) that is available with the unit, which relocates the excess heat out of the cavity above the fireplace to a desired location. This creates walls that are cool to the touch, allowing for lower mantel heights, and making it TV-friendly. For a short time, both the ZRB46 (TBD) and the VRB46 will be available at NW Stoves.

Saber Grills Cool Touch Grill Brush

There has been talk in the news lately about wire brushes being used for cleaning grills. The wire bristles can dislodge from the brush and get stuck in the food you’re grilling, thus become a choking hazard. I can personally speak to this because it recently happened to me. Fortunately, the wire only got stuck in my throat in a place that was uncomfortable and not life-threatening and I was able to dislodge it after a few minutes. But that brush quickly found its way to our trash, having been replaced by Saber’s Cool Touch Grill Brush. The Cool Touch Brush has



abrasive bristles that can last up to 5 times longer than wire brushes. A replacement head is available and the head is removable for easy cleaning or replacement. A SS mesh replacement head is also available for cleaning the grill while it’s still hot.




Ride to Conquer Cancer
